Island Brewery Nipper Bitter	Straw coloured, light and refreshing, with a distinguishable balance of malt and hops, and a satisfyingly moreish after-bite. Its character displays the familiar qualities of traditional brewing at its best.	3.8%	9g
Plain Inn the Sun	Pleasant Belgian style Blonde ale.	3.8%	9g
Ringwood Best (Razorback)	Tempting hop aroma with fruit notes Good malt feel in the mouth, dry, tangy fruit finish. Delicious, easy drinking slightly tart pale bitter.	3.8%	9g
Bosuns Down the Hatch	This blonde beer has a fruity citrus nose. Brewed using American Cascade hops as it's main hop it has a citrus taste with a hint of lemon. Although it has a good hoppy taste, it remains a great session beer.	4.0%	9g
Island Brewery Wight Gold	Crystal malt, golden brown, with rounded malt and hops throughout, creating that characteristic refreshing after-bite of a true craft brew that makes a favourite.	4.0%	9g
Box Steam Soul Train	A blonde, continental style beer with a hoppy and fruity aroma and a refreshing citrus taste.	4.0%	9g
Sharp's Doom Bar	Amber colour. Balanced complex blend of dried fruit, lightly roasted malt and subtle bitterness. Dry & refreshing finish.	4.0%	9g
Thwaites Wainwright	Brewed as one of the celebratory beers for Thwaites bi-centenary. Named after Alfred Wainwright, the renowned Lakeland author who was born in Blackburn in 1907. A refreshing straw-coloured beer with soft fruit flavours and a hint of sweetness from the fine malt.	4.1%	9g
Fullers London Pride	Fuller's London Pride is an award-winning classic. A rich, smooth and wonderfully balanced beer, its distinctive malty base is complemented by well-developed hop character, from adding Target, Challenger and Northdown varieties to the brew.	4.1%	9g

Young's City Scape Beer	A punchy, golden ale to celebrate the brewery's 188 th birthday.	4.2%	9g

Sharps Atlantic IPA	Atlantic is a deep golden colour. The aroma of Pale Ale is a blend of stunning citrus notes, juicy tropical fruits and fresh-picked hops with a touch of candy floss. The flavour has a delicate sweetness with fruity succulence and citrus spice to the fore. The finish is sweet at first becoming dry and lingering with hop zest.	4.2%	9G
Bosuns King Neptune	This is a full bodied blonde to light golden in colour. Brewed using American hops. This beer has a very fruity nose and finishes with a burst of citrus and grapefruit flavours.	4.3%	9g
Bass	Brewed to 4.4% abv, Draught Bass is still brewed to an original recipe using only the finest ingredients and the experience of generations. It is brewed with two strains of yeast to produce a complex nutty, malty taste with subtle hop undertones.	4.4%	10g
Island Brewery Hop Aboard	This golden ale with its hop aromas and touch of tropical citrus in the taste combined with a smooth and zesty finish certainly makes you want to stop for more.	4.5%	9g

Wantsum Black Pig	Nickname for the Spanish Armada, whose wreckage was washed up on the coast near Deal after they were sunk by the English fleet and weather. Adapted from an imperial Russian porter recipe, this beer is incredibly smooth with burnt chocolate and smoky malt notes mixed with delicate hop bitterness and floral notes	4.8%	9g
Island Brewery Vectis Venom	Easy drinking because of its deceptive character, this ruby tinted dark brown ale has an underlying smoothness that enables it to penetrate and deliver its potion in the most satisfying of ways, malt and hops personified...	4.8%	9g

(Rich Dark Ale)	<u>Isle of Wight CAMRA Beer of the Year 2014/2015/2016/2017/2018</u> <u>World Beer Award Gold 2016</u> <u>Silver Medal Winner SIBA South East Beer Festival 2014</u> A Rich, dark ale (R.D.A). Made with crystal and chocolate malts along with roasted barley. An ale that tastes superb and is extremely moreish with a glorious cappuccino aftertaste. Named after 'Earl' the sunflower emblem of the Earl Mountbatten Hospice. 10p for every pint sold will be donated to the Hospice by the Island Brewery.	5.0%	9g

Nethergate Old Growler	The legendary Old Growler - what a pedigree, what a porter! Like a grumpy old family pet much loved for its independent character and suffer-no-fools attitude, yet its curmudgeonly appearance belying its gentle character and easy going nature. The only beer to have twice won Overall Champion at the CAMRA Winter Beer Festival; its many awards also include Supreme Champion at the Chicago International Beer Festival and voted Best of 2011 by the Beer Tasting Institute of America, so it's even top dog across the pond. A complex, satisfying Porter, smooth and distinctive. Roast malt and fruit feature on the palate and the finish is powerfully hoppy.	5.0%	9g
Wantsum 10 Year Anniversary Ale	A strong English golden ale	5.2%	9g
Milestone Missy Sippy Jazz Ale	Full bodied ale brewed with American hops.	5.5%	9g
Heritage Masterpiece	Masterpiece is a classic strong pale ale named after one of the original dray horses at the then Bass Museum. Aromatic hops, toasted cereal notes and hints of smoke and spice enhanced by fragrant fruity character and a top note of fresh bread. A full luxurious mouth-feel combines with a subtle peppery character to create an exquisite finish.	5.6%	9g
