<b>Upham</b> Last Suspect	Chestnut in colour with a touch of sweetness. An easy drinking ale named after the Grand National Winner 1985	3.8%	9g
<b>Nethergate</b> Lounge Lizard	Orange and Apricot monopolize this bronze best bitter with an outstanding aroma and an even better finish. Clean cut and grassy in its entirety.	3.8%	9g
